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Marcos Alaniz reported that they are working to get the arsenic & TDS levels down in their system after City of Corpus Christi started using the wells. He will put the topic of our system connection to NCWCID #3 on the agenda for next month's meeting in April. We are still going ahead with this connection so we can work on getting out of our violation with TCEQ. Any plans we have are simply put on hold for now. Hector Benavidez reported that we had a leak a few hours before the meeting down the road on CR 61. The customer was doing something with the service and broke a valve on the meter on VWSC side. NCWCID #3 will order a new valve and meter for this customer. NCWCID #3 guys will be working on getting old meters changed out to the new digital meters after meter reading. We will need to order new meters once our stock is installed. There have not been any big issues arise since last meeting.

The old tank at Pump Station #2 was demolished by Bulldog Steel. Hector reported they are building the new one and everything seems to be going well. No reports of any issues. The electrician has ordered what he needs to fix the electrical issues with the pump stations and generator.

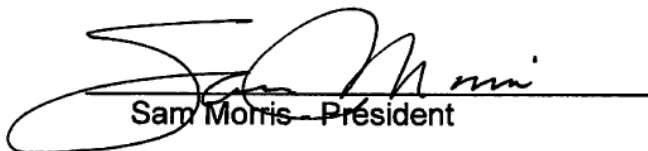
