## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT DRINKING WATER MONITORING REQUIREMENTS NOT MET FOR VIOLET WATER SUPPLY CORP.**

Our system failed to collect every required coliform sample. Although this incident was not an emergency, as our customers, you have the right to know what happened and what we are doing to correct this situation.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During May 2025, we did not complete all monitoring or testing for coliform bacteria and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

There is nothing you need to do at this time. You may continue to drink the water. If a situation arises where the water is no longer safe to drink, we are required to notify you within 24 hours.

We collected every required coliform sample in the month of June and July 2025 and are no longer in violation. For more information, please contact Violet Water Supply at 361-387-3350 or 3861 CR 61, Robstown, Texas, 78380.
